WILSON'S MITIGATION PLAN

Please take a moment to review Wilson's complete Mitigation Plan with your family.

AT HOME DAILY HEALTH SCREENINGS

Students must not come to school if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, or chills;
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing;
- muscle aches;
- sore throat;
- headache;
- fatigue;
- congestion or runny nose;
- cough;
- vomiting;
- diarrhea; or
- new loss of taste or smell.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP PROCEDURES

- A staff member will visually check each student prior to students entering the campus.
- Students will be dropped off and picked up from school without parents getting out of the car, with very limited exception and with expressed permission from a site administrator that is provided for good cause.
- If the parent walks a student to school, the parent will not be allowed to enter the school or grounds and must drop off the student outside of the school campus.

BUSES

- Passengers and bus drivers must wear a mask on school buses regardless of the mask policy at school. The CDC's order applies to all public transportation conveyances including school buses.
- Students will stand together, at the bus stop, while still observing social distancing guidelines.
- All students will be required to hand sanitize prior to boarding the bus.
- The bus driver will instruct students where to sit so that students are as spread out as possible.
- Buses will be disinfected at a minimum before and after daily routes.

SOCIAL DISTANCING & HAND WASHING

Staff members will educate and remind students regularly to maintain at least 3 feet of distance between individuals at all times possible. All students and staff will wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol at the following times:

- upon arrival at school (use hand sanitizer if there is no sink in the classroom),
- after being outside for physical activity,
- before and after lunch,
- prior to leaving school for home,
- after sneezing, coughing, or blowing nose, and
- Prior to and after removing and putting on a face mask.

VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

The District will limit nonessential visitors and volunteers at school except for the safety and well-being of students. Parents will report to the front office and not go beyond unless it is for safety or well-being of their child and must follow all safety protocols including physically distancing, as feasible.
